


## JOINT RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION BY THE CITY OF MORGANTOWN, MONONGALIA COUNTY, TOWN OF STAR CITY, CITY OF WESTOVER, TOWN OF GRANVILLE, AND TOWN OF BLACKSVILLE, ESTABLISHING THE MORGANTOWN-MONONGALIA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION AS THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, SUPPERSEDING ANY PREVIOUS RESOLUTIONS.

- WHEREAS, based upon the 2000 U.S. Census Bureau's determination that the City of Morgantown and surrounding area qualifies as an urbanized area within the United States of America identified in the May 1, 2002 Federal Register, volume 67, number 84, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 134 and Section 8 of the Federal Transit Act, as amended, a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) must be designated for each urbanized area that is responsible for a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs that considers all major transportation modes and supports metropolitan community development and social goals, and;
- WHEREAS, The Morgantown-Monongalia County Transportation Planning Organization is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the designated Morgantown Urbanized Area and will cover the area encompassed by the Monongalia County boundaries, and;
- WHEREAS, Federal and State Legislation requires metropolitan planning review of public facilities and grant applications, and;
- WHEREAS, Designation of metropolitan planning organization (MPO) shall be by agreement among the Governor and units of general purpose local governments representing 75 percent of the affected metropolitan population (including the central city as defined by the Bureau of the Census).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Morgantown, Monongalia County, the Town of Star City, the City of Westover, Town of Granville and the Town of Blacksville, create a Metropolitan Planning Organization to be known as the "Morgantown-Monongalia County Transportation Planning Organization".




