Please find below a short description of the items to be considered at the June 18, 2015 Policy Board Meeting to be held in Morgantown City Hall in the Conference Room at 6 PM.

**-Transportation Improvement Program Amendments-**The Division of Highways has requested the following TIP Amendments:

## FY 2015 Add

-Caperton Rail Trail Connector-Add Connector to River Landing Shopping Center in Star City Engineering Project Number STD2015040TDC Total Cost \$28,000. Federal Funds \$28,000 Construction Project Number STD2015041TDC Total Cost \$92,000 Federal Funds \$73,600

This project is for creation of a paved connection between the Rail Trail and the Rivers Landing Shopping Center in Star City. Rivers Landing includes a drug store and a restaurant. The Citizens Advisory Committee and the Transportation Technical Advisory Committee respectfully recommended the approval of this TIP Amendment.

-**MPO Traffic Count Report**-Please find enclosed the MPO's Traffic Count Report for 2015. It is respectfully requested that the Policy Board accept this report.

-Committee for Revision of the MPO's Public Involvement Policy-The UPWP for the upcoming year includes the revision of the MPO's Public Involvement Policy. Discussions with the Policy Board have indicated that the MPO should take a more proactive approach to public outreach. If interested Policy Board Members may agree to serve on a committee to revise the Public Involvement Policy and to work to develop a public outreach strategy to include with the Policy. It is anticipated that the work of this committee may take up to two meetings.
